The Office of Safety and Mission Assurance requests a waiver (in accordance with NPR 1400.1) for 30 days to address a nonconcurrency in the NASA Online Directives Information System (NODIS) for NPR 8715.6, NASA Procedural Requirements for Limiting Orbital Debris. The current date required for the signature package is September 7, 2016. The Office of Safety and Mission Assurance is working with the Human Exploration and Operations Mission Directorate (HEOMD) for a concurrence with the document content. An update to the draft document is in coordination with a projected response from the HEOMD on September 2, 2016. After receiving concurrence from the HEOMD, the signature package will begin routing in OSMA and then submitted to the Directives Management Team.


To properly address concerns, Safety and Mission Assurance requests additional time to provide the signature package.


